QUALIFICATIONS

To be eligible, you must adhere to the qualifications set forth in the 2009 U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook, Duties of Event Officials, rule 3432, pages 225-228. Any reference to 'the coach of such a competitor' refers to your role as 'a **primary** coach of such a competitor'. It is your responsibility to verify your qualifications. Please refer to the U.S. Figure Skating Advancement Guidelines if you are applying to advance your current certification.

COST

- \$125 for those seeking certification; \$75 for observers. Cost includes:
 - Three days of intensive IJS training
 - Testing for certification or advancement
 - Lunch provided on Friday and Saturday
 - International faculty
- Additional expenses including travel and hotel are the responsibility of each attendee.

TRAVEL INFORMATION

The Triangle SportsPlex is located about 28 miles from the Raleigh-Durham International Airport (RDU). The Holiday Inn Express is about the same distance and about two miles from the Triangle SportsPlex. Transportation from and to the airport is probably easiest by rental car as the seminar will be at a rink which is two miles away. Super Shuttle has fares of \$35 one way per person or \$66 round trip per person. If several people book and ride together, the additional person fee is \$10 per each. Advanced shuttle reservations are suggested; please call (800) 258-3826 or go to the web at www.supershuttle.com. Rooms are available at the Holiday Inn Express in Hillsborough, NC for \$89.99/night. APPLICATIONS

Applicants can only apply for certification or advancement in one discipline* (singles, pairs or dance) and one area (technical controller, technical specialist or data operator*). All applications must be completed online. Please note that you will need to include information on your competitive history, coaching history and technical panel history if you are applying for certification. All applications must be completed online by 11:59 p.m., Sunday, May 17 or they will be subject to a \$50 late fee. Payment must be submitted online at the time of application.

Applications will be reviewed for acceptance as they are received. If you are not accepted, your payment will be refunded. Late applications will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
