## U. S. Figure Skating Competition Information

### Facility

All events will be held at the Triangle SportsPlex, One Dan Kidd Drive, Hillsborough, NC 27278, (919) 644-0339. The facility is off I-85 at Exit 165. After exiting, follow the signs to the Sports Center. The ice rink is 85' x 200' with rounded corners and hockey barrier. The facility has a snack bar and sells figure skating supplies. The facility does not allow any food or drink to be brought inside. Dressing rooms are also available.

### System of Judging

For Juvenile (including Open Juvenile) through Senior free skate, pairs, and couples dance events, we will be using the International Judging System (IJS). Judges will be utilizing a computer system to enter marks. We will have video review for the technical panels. For all other events, we will be using the "6.0" system.

### Entries

The Central Carolina Skating Classic is open to all skaters in good standing with the United States Figure Skating Association and will be governed by the rules as specified in the 2010 US Figure Skating Rulebook, except as otherwise specified. Skaters may skate up one level, but may only enter one event in each category. **The Short programs in singles and pairs will be judged on the 2010-2011 requirements.** The short and long program will not be combined. Skaters will receive protocols for the full flight of skaters after the results are posted. Only the skater may pick up the protocols. The Ruth and Howard Jackson trophy will be awarded to the winner of the Intermediate Ladies Short final round. The Maxine Freeland Award will be given to the winner of the Juvenile Ladies Free Skate. The entry fee for all IJS events is \$110 for the first event, \$110 for each pair or dance team, and \$75 for each additional IJS event. If a skater skates an IJS event and a non-IJS event the non-IJS event will cost \$45. The entry fee for all Non IJS events is \$80 for the first event and \$45 for the second event. Mail the applications to: **Central Carolina Skating Classic, c/o Suzie Zeunges, 306 South Fourth Street, Mebane, NC 27302.** Entries must be postmarked by **February 22, 2010.** Please review your choice of events closely. **Any change of event as a result of your mistake will result in a \$25 fee for each event changed.** Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Competition Committee and may require a late fee of \$25.00. The Central Carolina Skating Club, Inc. reserves the right to divide or combine any event if necessary and to cancel any events (with full refund of entry fee). Otherwise, there will be **NO refunds.** All schedules and practice ice applications will be sent by e-mail. **DO NOT send a self-addressed stamped envelope.** As soon as they are available, they will also be on our web site at [www.centralcarolinasc.com](http://www.centralcarolinasc.com). If you do not have e-mail, please find someone that can access the information for you. The final schedule will be posted at the Triangle SportsPlex. There will also be a US Figure Skating Basic Skills Competition running at the same time. That application/ announcement is separate and can be obtained on the website or through e-mail.

### Awards

Medals will be awarded to the **1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th** place winners in each event. If the number of entrants requires multiple groups, medals will be awarded to each group.

### Music

Cassette tapes or CDs must be clearly marked with the skater's name and event. All tapes (must be rewind) or CDs (one piece of music only per CD) must be turned in to the registration desk at least one (1) hour prior to the event. It is **advisable and recommended** to have a backup tape or CD.

### Registration

The registration desk will be open throughout the competition. Skaters must check in at least one hour prior to the event.

### Admission

Spectator admission is free to all events. There is limited seating for watching the events.

### Video and Photography

Professional video taping and photography of each event will be available. Except for the official videographers, only battery-operated cameras will be allowed. Individual video taping will be permitted in designated areas only. There will be **NO** flash photography permitted in the ice arena.

**DANCE—COUPLES**

All dances and age requirements will be as listed in the rule book for the 2009-2010 season. Each event listed is a separate event and will not be combined. Ties will be broken by total ordinals of the simple majority/TO/second dance.

Pre-Juvenile Dance Compulsory Event 1-Rhythm Blues, Canasta Tango Compulsory Event 2-Cha Cha, Swing Dance; 6.0 Judging (Must have passed at least 2 standard Preliminary dance tests, but no higher than the pre-bronze dance test. Under 14 years old.)

Juvenile Compulsory and Free dance Compulsory Dances are the Willow Waltz and Ten Fox. IJS (Must have passed preliminary dance and the juvenile free dance test. Under 16 years old.)

Intermediate Compulsory and Free dance Compulsory Dances are the Rocker Foxtrot and European Waltz. IJS (Must have passed the bronze dance test or higher and the intermediate free dance test.)

Novice Compulsory and Free dance Compulsory Dances are the American Waltz and Paso Doble. IJS (Must have passed at least one dance of the silver dance test and the novice free dance test.)

**ARTISTIC EVENTS** (No jump higher than an Axel. Event will be judged on artistic impression and interpretation of the music. Skater will provide music. Costumes may enhance the program by appropriately reflecting the music and the theme. No props are allowed on the ice. Hand-held props may be used but may not be put down.) 6.0 Judging

**SHOWCASE** (Eligibility requirements are the same as for free skating. All showcase programs shall be skated on full ice with music, which may utilize vocals. There are no required elements. Emphasis is placed on the theatrical and entertainment value of the skater's performance rather than on technical accuracy of specific moves. Therefore, only a presentation mark will be given. Costumes and props are encouraged to help illustrate the act. Props are limited to those that skaters can hand carry or push out onto the ice themselves in one trip. Their set-up should not be more than 30 seconds. Skaters may not be assisted during the set-up time nor assisted from off ice during the number. If the skater has any assistance getting their prop on or off the ice, a deduction of 0.5 will be taken. Props may not be flame- or smoke-oriented nor may they be live. Deductions will be taken for anything left on the ice such as paper, feathers, glitter, or anything else that could cause harm to another skater.) 6.0 Judging
