**Technique, Artistry & Presentation** is a 5 hour on and off-ice clinic led by 1992 Olympic Silver Medalist and PSA Master Rated Coach, **Paul Wylie**. Paul is known for his exquisite artistry, sharp and controlled footwork and proven jump and spin technique.



### **Adult Seminar**

The Adult TAP Seminar is open to adults (18 or older) of all skill levels. This all-adult seminar will participate in all on- and off-ice sessions separately from the Youth Edges & Artistry skaters.

### **Youth Seminar:**

The Youth TAP seminar is open to skaters Freeskate 1 or higher. There will be two separate clinics:
